Return unused and expired prescription & over-the-counter medications\* to your local pharmacy for safe, free disposal.



Check with your local pharmacy for its policy on the disposal of used sharps (needles, glucose testing strips, lancets, etc)

# Medication ROUND-UP

*Why is it important to properly dispose of medication?*

Proper disposal is a matter of safety. Having unused or expired medication accumulating within your home increases the likelihood that the medication will be taken after it is expired or by someone for whom it was not prescribed.

*What do I need to do to prepare my medication to be disposed of?*

To protect your privacy, cover your name and personal information with a black marker or remove the label.

*Will I be asked my name or any other personal information?*

No, this service is anonymous.

*Regularly returning unused and expired medication will help reduce the likelihood of misuse or poisoning. Anytime you have medication that needs to be disposed of, you can return it to the pharmacy you purchased it at.*
