

A letter to your Town Council is required if a block party requires a road closure. In the letter you can request that the Town provides the block party area with sufficient barricades if needed in order to close the road properly. Please submit a letter to Town Council at least 30 days prior to the event taking place.

As well, you will need to contact your Town Office to inquire into potential insurance requirements if the block party will occur on a Town road or property. Insurance would be necessary if any alcohol will be served or any type of large novelty items would be used and placed on a public road (such as bouncy castles, trampolines, blow-up rides, etc.)

Music or any loud noises are accepted within reason but we would ask that they respect the Nuisance Bylaw which states that quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am.
